<u>FSU Grants for completing a doctorate</u>	In order to make sure that doctorate projects can move from an advanced stage to completion, the FSU Jena grants candidates special grants, which amount to € 1,000 per month. <u>MLU – Teaching and Research Assistantships</u>	<p>The MLU awards Teaching (TA) and Research Assistantships (RA) to matriculated foreign PhD students of the University. PhD supervisors can apply for an assistantship for up to 3 months and for a sum of approx. 300 € net per month to be paid to graduate assistants under a contract. They accept first applications as well as applications for renewal.
